



	What are some of the things God has done for you this week that have blessed and enriched your life?
	How does this inequity motivate you to repent of sin and fight temptation?
3.	Describe a situation in your life when pride kept you from confessing and repenting of a particular sin?
	How did the delay of repentance in your life compound the problem?
4.	Describe a situation in your life in which God had to spank you more than once for the same sin.
