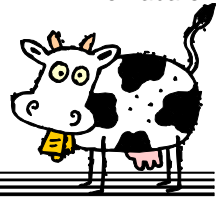

2. Read **Romans 6:23** and **Revelation 20:14-15**. What are some of the reasons it is important to retain a sense of the severity of sin's ultimate consequence, even after becoming a Christian?

3. Read **Isaiah 53:5-7**. In your own words, describe the cost to Christ to gain your forgiveness.

What practical steps can you take to maintain a loftier appreciation for the cost of your salvation?

4. Read **2 Corinthians 5:21**. Write out a "Christ directed" expression of your gratitude for the sacrifice of Jesus on your behalf.
