¹¹ I long to see you so that I may impart to you some spiritual gift to make you strong—12 that is, that you and I may be mutually encouraged by each other's faith. 13 I do not want you to be unaware, brothers, that I planned many times to come to you (but have been prevented from doing so until now) in order that I might have a harvest among you, just as I have had among the other Gentiles. 14 I am obligated both to Greeks and non-Greeks, both to the wise and the foolish. 15 That is why I am so eager to preach the gospel also to you who are at Rome. - 4. How would you explain to someone the effect that investing in other people's conversion and spiritual growth has on your own spiritual growth?
- 5. What is your reaction to knowing that the world and the spiritual enemies of God would have you shut up regarding the advancement of the gospel?
- 6. Read **Ephesians 6:10-20**. How does this description of armor help you as it relates to sharing the gospel "fearlessly" as we should?
