- 4. What are some of the short-term, earthbound penalties that result from breaking God's rules about sex?
- 5. What instructions would you give to someone looking for God's forgiveness regarding sexual sin?
- 5. Read 1 Corinthians 6:18-20. What does this passage add to our understanding of God's authority over our sexual activities?
