⁶ God "will give to each person according to what he has done." ⁷To those who by persistence in doing good seek glory, honor and immortality, he will give eternal life. ⁸ But for those who are self-seeking and who reject the truth and follow evil, there will be wrath and anger. ⁹There will be trouble and distress for every human being who does evil: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile; 10 but glory, honor and peace for everyone who does good: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile. 11 For God does not show favoritism. - 4. What does pondering God's judgment do to you?
- 5. How does a proper understanding of sin and judgment make God's grace more precious to you?
- 6. What specific effects of genuine repentance do you see at work in your life?
