Romans 2:17-24

<sup>17</sup> Now you, if you call yourself a Jew; if you rely on the law and brag about your relationship to God; <sup>18</sup> if you know his will and approve of what is superior because you are instructed by the law; 19 if you are convinced that you are a quide for the blind, a light for those who are in the dark, <sup>20</sup> an instructor of the foolish, a teacher of infants, because you have in the law the embodiment of knowledge and truth— 21 you, then, who teach others, do you not teach yourself? You who preach against stealing, do you steal? <sup>22</sup> You who say that people should not commit adultery, do you commit adultery? You who abhor idols, do you rob temples? 23 You who brag about the law, do you dishonor God by breaking the law? <sup>24</sup> As it is written: "God's name is blasphemed among the Gentiles because of you." (NIV)

## **Application Questions**

- 2. Read **Romans 3:20-21**. What are some of the things you trusted in to be acceptable to God before you followed the example of Paul in Philippians 3:7 and realized that Christ had to earn your acceptability for you?
- 3. Read **James 2:10-11**. Why does it make sense (especially in light of the cross) that God does not and cannot grade on a curve when it comes to holiness?
- 4. What were some "broken laws" of Scripture that convinced you that you were not "good enough" to be accepted by God on your own merits?

How would you respond to someone who thinks he is good enough to go to heaven without Christ?

5. What specifically can you do to minimize hypocrisy at this point in your Christian life?
