Application Questions

These questions are provided for your further study and application of today's sermon. Thoughtfully writing out the answers to these questions will help to drive home the point of today's study. It is also helpful when you are able to discuss your answers with others.

- 1. Read **Jeremiah 4:4** and **Deuteronomy 30:6**. The Old Testament Jews often relied on the external sign of circumcision instead of looking for the internal reality of a heart transformed by God's grace. What are some of the externals that people wrongly rely on today, instead of acquiring by faith a heart made new by God's grace?
- 2. Read Romans 2:16. Why is the heart a much more difficult arena to assess than the external forms of religion?
- 3. Describe the difference between the inward realities of real conversion to Christ and the external conformity to a religious community's ceremonial standards. How would one know if one is simply "going through the motions" or expressing internal realities with external actions?
- 4. When Paul speaks of "praise from God" in v.29 he is logically contrasting the "praise from men" that is so easily and quickly bestowed on those who participate in the external activities associated with God's people. How can we be careful to rightly encourage, yet not to give misleading affirmation when people today "walk an aisle," "pray a prayer" or get baptized?
