
1. The Varied Ways Reality is Perceived C. A Spectrum of Worldviews












2. Biblical Theism & Perceptible Reality E. A God Who Explains the God Concept 1) Anthropological Observations (Observations of Intuition) Atheism only about 10% in USA -- 50% of Atheists believe in Heaven & Hell -- 13% of Atheists believe that "accepting Christ" will secure them heaven

2. Biblical Theism & Perceptible Reality

- 1) It is possible an absolutely perfect being exists
- 2) If possible, then it exists in some possible world
- 3) If in some possible world, then in every world
- 4) If in every possible world, then in the actual world
- 5) Therefore God exists in the actual world
- * In Short:
- 1) We can conceive of a perfect being
- 2) Existence is a necessary part of such a being
- 3) A perfect being exists
