- 3. Read **Psalm 39:4-6** and **Psalm 90:10-12**. Why is it healthy and good for us to periodically take an honest look at our own mortality and impermanence?
- 4. Read **John 11:5-44**. What stands out in your reading of this demonstration of Christ's authority over death and his call to trust him in the face of death?
- 5. Read **Philippians 1:20-24**. Can you say that because of your current relationship with Christ your attitude toward death is as fearless and confident as the Apostle Paul's in this passage? If not, why? If so, when did that begin?
- 6. In what specific ways are you showing your reliance on Christ to live your life in a more biblical and godly way?
