2. Is the "Word" Really "God"? **B. Greek Grammar: The Article** (English) Definite Article: "the" (English) Indefinite Article: "a" or "an" **Definite:** I want to go to (the) restaurant. Indefinite: I want to go to arestaurant.

2. Is the "Word" Really "God"? **B. Greek Grammar: The Article** • Definite Article: "the" (various inflections) Indefinite Article: (none) **Definite:** I want to go to (the) restaurant. Indefinite: I want to go to restaurant.




2. Is the "Word" Really "God"? **B. Greek Grammar: The Article** If a noun has an article it is ALWAYS definite.

 If a noun does not have an article it may be definite OR indefinite.


2. Is the "Word" Really "God"? **B. Greek Grammar: The Article** Greek word order is fluid! -- Greek inflections avoid confusion

"Great was the Sermon." "Smashed John the bike." "Eat we should the sandwiches." "Tacos eat we should."


