- 1. Read **2 Corinthians 4:3-4**. Besides our inability to get all of our evangelistic prospects to see Christ for who he is, what are some of the frustrations of living during an age when "the god of this world" is not Jesus Christ?
- 2. Read **Revelation 11:15**. Describe some of the reasons every Christian should joyfully anticipate this day.
- 3. Read **Matthew 5:11-12**. What are some of the reasons it is difficult to respond the way Jesus told us we should when we are belittled or ridiculed for our allegiance to Christ?
- 4. Read **Revelation 1:9**. Why do these three go so naturally together? (i.e., John's current tribulations, John's citizenship in the coming kingdom, and John's patient endurance.)
- 5. Read **Philippians 2:6-10**. In what ways should a wholehearted confidence in Christ's Lordship and our coming vindication change the way we live now?
