## **Application Questions**

These questions are provided for your further study and application of today's sermon. Thoughtfully writing out the answers to these questions will help to drive home the point of today's study. It is also helpful when you are able to discuss your answers with others

- 1. Read **Romans 5:20** and **1 Peter 1:14-16**. What would you say to someone who says that God's laws don't matter because we are saved by grace?
- 2. Read **Hebrews 10:1-4** and **1 John 3:4-10**. When the New Testament references "the law" or "law-breaking" why is it so important for us to note which aspect of the Old Testament law the passage is referencing?
- 3. Read **2 Corinthians 5:17** and **Hebrews 10:16-17**. Based on passages like these, why is the genuineness of our conversion in Christ (i.e., a real, authentic, internal, "new birth" which took place when we repented of our sins and placed our trust in Christ to forgive us) so important in any discussion about keeping God's rules or being more holy?
- 4. Why is it a problem for us to attempt to "love others" without ever calibrating our understanding of "love" by the definitions we find in the Bible? In other words, why not just rely on what our new "regenerate hearts" feel?
- 5. What specific, righteous acts of Christlike love will you purposefully demonstrate (and to whom) this week?
