- 3. Read **Ephesians 4:11-12**. How would you respond to those who say that they are looking for a more tranquil kind of church environment where they don't have to get involved in volunteering or serving?
- 4. Read **Acts 4:4**; **5:14**; **6:7**. What are some of the assummed disruptions to church life that come as a result of being obedient to Christ's commission by constantly focusing on the making of disciples?
- 5. How can this week's sermon help to shape the way you pray for our church's programs, our church's future, and our church's highly committed participants?
