## **Application Questions**

- 3. Read **Psalm 119:97-104**. How do you explain the "love" Christians have for spending time in God's word? How can you testify to a changed (and developing) appetite for the Bible? (cf. Heb.5:13-14.)
- 4. Read **Ecclesiastes 2:1-11**. In what way can you attest to the truths Solomon speaks of in this passage? How have you observed the vanity of life without God?
- 5. Read **1 Timothy 4:8**. Why is it so important that we don't just see the benefit of godliness as something realized in the next life? What are some of the oftoverlooked benefits of living for Christ in this life?
