Application Questions

These questions are provided for your further study and application of today's sermon. Thoughtfully writing out the answers to these questions will help to drive home the point of today's study. It is also helpful when you are able to discuss your answers with others.

- 1. Read **Philippians 2:3-8**. How are you doing at maintaining this mindset, particularly as it relates to your involvement in and assessment of your church? How should this passage change the way you view church?
- 2. Read **Luke 12:15-21**. What are some of the factors that make being "rich toward God" so difficult and following the pattern of the world (and the man in this parable) so tempting?
- 3. Read **2 Corinthians 9:6-15**. What specific motivations found in this passage prompt you to be more faithful and generous in giving to the Lord's work?
- 4. Read **Colossians 4:12**. Based on the noteworthy example of Epaphras, what specifically should be adjusted in your prayer life?
- 5. Read **Ephesians 4:11-16**. How does a healthy church (like the one described in this passage) indirectly encourage the individuals in it to actually engage in the work of the Great Commission?
