- 4. Read **Daniel 3:15-18**. What are some of the ways we can help to cultivate Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego's kind of fearless strength in our children?
- 5. Read **1 Corinthians 4:7**. How should the truth of this text govern your thoughts and words when you or your children do something significant for the cause of Christ?
