

1. Church "Membership" A. An Important Distinction Cultural "Membership" vs. Biblical "Membership" B. The Biblical Words for "Member"

bouleuth,j (bouleutes)

Definition

From the word "to consult"

Officially participating in "the council"

Occurrence in NT = 2 (Mk.15:43; Lk.23:50)

ESV Translation

"member of the council" (x2)

Usage

(Literal) of councilman Joseph of Arimet.

su,nswmoj (sunsomos) Definition With + Body or Together + Body Occurrence in NT = 1 (Eph.3:6) **ESV** Translation "members of the same body"

Usage

(Metaphorical) of Gentiles made a part of God's program

oivkei/oj (oikeios)


- **Definition** = "of a house"
- Occurrence in NT = 2
- **ESV** Translation
- "members of his/the household"

Usage

- 1) (1Tim.5:8) (Literal) of the same home
- 2) (Eph.2:19) (Metaphorical) of the same redeemed group

me,loj (melos)

- **Definition** = "limb" or "appendage" **Occurrence** in NT = 34 **ESV Translation**
 - 1) "member(s)" = 28xs
 - 2) "parts" = 2xs
 - 3) "you" = 2xs
 - 4) [untranslated] = 2xs ("member" impl.)



me,loj (melos) Usage

- 2) (Metaphorical) of Christian bodies belonging to Christ
 - this meaning = 2xs
 - 1Cor.6:15
- 3) (Metaphorical) of bodies sexually connected to a prostitute (1x = v.15)

me,loj (melos) Usage

- 4) (Metaphorical) of Christians belonging to the same fellowship
 - this meaning = 9xs
 - e.g., 1Cor.12:12-27

Eph.4:25; 5:28-32

Rom.12:5

- 1. Church "Membership"
 - C. Principles Drawn from the Analogy
 - 1) All Christians are Inseparably Related to Christ (1Cor.6:15)
 - 2) Christians Should be Content to Serve Differing Roles in the Church (12:12)
 - 3) Every Role in the Church is Important (12:22)

- 1. Church "Membership"
 - C. Principles Drawn from the Analogy
 - 4) Christians Must Have Mutual Respect for Each Other (12:26-27)
 - 5) Our Interconnectedness Should Keep us from Sinning Against Each Other (Eph.4:25)

1. Church "Membership"

D. Observations

- 1) "Formal Church Membership" cannot be based on the "Member Texts"
- 2) "Biblical Church Membership" = Everyone Substantially Participating
- 3) "Formal Church Membership" may be a Requested for Practical Reasons
