Application Questions

These questions are provided for your further study and application of today's sermon. Thoughtfully writing out the answers to these questions will help to drive home the point of today's study. It is also helpful when you are able to discuss your answers with others.

- 1. Read **Romans 5:6-9**. Why do you think some Christians fail to cherish the love and compassion of Christ that motivated their costly salvation?
- 2. Read **Genesis 3:17-19**. How does this clear statement of God's universal sentence on the human race help us to manage our expectations regarding physical healings and prolonged life?
- 3. Read **John 11:25-27**. In the middle of this scene where Christ raises Lazarus (only to die again years later), Jesus directs our ultimate hope where it belongs, while Martha acknowledges Jesus' biblical status as "the Christ" and the "Son of God." Why are these two things so important as we are made to endure our own illnesses and to eventually face our own physical death?
- 4. Read **Psalm 18:1-6**. Though the historical context for this psalm is a specific temporal deliverance (and in that way, similar to those in Luke 4), how can this response from David help to deepen and define our own worship when we consider our deliverance from the eternal consequences of our sins?
