Application Questions

These questions are provided for your further study and application of today's sermon. Thoughtfully writing out the answers to these questions will help to drive home the point of today's study. It is also helpful when you are able to discuss your answers with others.

- 1. Read **Luke 5:8-11**. While these men admittedly received a special calling to be a part of Christ's first-century team of disciples (and later Apostles), all of us are called to engage in the Great Commission (Mt.28:19-20) to be "ambassadors of Christ" (2Cor.5:17-20) to our own generation. With that in mind how does the response of Peter in this passage provide a good template for us when we consider evangelism in our own daily lives?
- 2. Read Matthew 6:31-33. What would you say to the guy who tells you that he has no time for sharing the gospel with others because he has to focus on making a living and excelling in his work? How can these statements from Christ to the crowds in Galilee be applied, knowing that God expects Christians to work diligently at their careers?
- 3. Read 1 Corinthians 3:10-15 and 2 Corinthians 4:16-18. How do these passages motivate you to keep investing in the most important things?
- 4. Read **Ephesians 6:19-20**. List a few of the specific things you will pray for this week regarding the people in your life who need to better understand the gospel and rightly respond to it.
