Application Questions

- 1. Read **Acts 14:21-23**. Why is it important for us, like it was for the Christians in Lystra, Iconium, and Antioch, to be reminded that the Christian life will include "many tribulations" before we enter the coming kingdom?
- 2. Read **John 16:33**. How does the last sentence of this verse actually help us to manage the forecast found earlier in the verse? How would you practically explain the help derived from this perspective when life hurts?
- 3. Read **Romans 8:18-25**. What aspects of this passage are the most helpful to you when you encounter some of life's profound sorrows?
- 4. Read **Matthew 6:16-18**. What can you do to make sure that when you participate in fasting it never becomes a prideful display or an attempt at manipulating God?
- 5. Read **Acts 2:46-47**. What specifically will you do to imitate the example of these two verses, which clearly helped to give the embattled early church perspective, camaraderie, and genuine joy?
