- 1. Read **Psalm 73:3-14**. What are some of the modern "inequities" which make it appear that sin and compromise are more advantageous and more satisfying than doing what God's word tells us?
- 2. Read **Hebrews 11:32-38**. Why is this description of biblical characters the kind of thing that makes Christianity an unattractive consideration for thoughtful non-Christians? How would you respond to their aversion?
- 3. Read **1 Peter 2:4-12**. What truths do you find in this text that clearly offset the earthly disadvantages that surface throughout the passage?
- 4. Read **Hebrews 11:24-27**. How can you apply this passage when you are faced with the costs of being faithful to Christ?
- 5. Read **Revelation 21:1-8** and **22:1-7**. Carefully think through the implications of some of these promises. How can you keep this in mind more than you have in the past, and what difference do you think that will make in your life?
