- 2. Read **Matthew 10:34-39**. Why do you think this truth is so frequently disregarded in the modern church in this part of the world?
- 3. Read **2 Corinthians 2:14-17**. What aspects of this passage should motivate and encourage those Christians who simply want to "live their Christianity" without ever speaking up about Christ? And what in this passage identifies the reason so many Christians are afraid to speak up about Christ?
- 4. Read **Galatians 1:10**. How would you counsel and advise a Christian who has an noticeable craving for people's approval?
- 5. Read **Romans 8:18** and **Hebrews 11:26**. What can you do to make these kinds of promises more specific and substantial in your mind?
