 - B. The Holy Spirit's Work of Conviction John 16:7-11
 - 1) Meaning
 - Elengcho (NT = 17xs; LXX = 57xs)
 - -- To Convince (of a fault)
 - -- To Refute (a wrong assumption)
 - -- To Expose (show a problem)

- B. The Holy Spirit's Work of Conviction2) Types of Experience
 - a) Without Salvation

Acts 24:24-27 [Felix] sent for Paul and heard him speak about faith in Christ Jesus. And as he reasoned about righteousness and self-control and the coming judgment, Felix was alarmed and said, "Go away for the present. When I get an opportunity I will summon you."

- B. The Holy Spirit's Work of Conviction2) Types of Experience
 - a) Without Salvation
- 2 Peter 2:15–16 Forsaking the right way, they have gone astray. They have followed the way of Balaam, the son of Beor, who loved gain from wrongdoing, but was rebuked for his own transgression; a speechless donkey spoke with human voice and restrained the prophet's madness.

2. "Regeneration"B. The Holy Spirit's Work of Conviction2) Types of Experienceb) With Salvation

1 Thessalonians 1:4-10 For we know, brothers loved by God, that he has chosen you, because our gospel came to you not only in word, but also in power and in the Holy Spirit and with full conviction... for you received the word in much affliction, with the joy of the Holy Spirit, ...they themselves report concerning us the kind of reception we had among you, and how you turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God

A. Biblical Confusion Based OnTransitional Timing in the Gospels & Acts1) Disciples in the Gospels Not Indwelt

John 14:16-17 And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever, even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, for he dwells with you and will be in you.

Remember Later NT Absolutes Re: HS

- Romans 8:9 Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him.
- Romans 5:5 God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.
- Galatians 3:2 Did you received the Spirit by works of the law or by hearing with faith?
- Galatians 4:6 And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts crying, "Abba! Father!"

A. Biblical Confusion Based OnTransitional Timing in the Gospels & Acts2) Some Disciples in Acts Not Indwelt

Acts 1:8 But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

- A. Biblical Confusion Based OnTransitional Timing in the Gospels & Acts2) Some Disciples in Acts Not Indwelt
 - A) Jerusalem
 - Acts 2:4 And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance.

- A. Biblical Confusion Based OnTransitional Timing in the Gospels & Acts2) Some Disciples in Acts Not Indwelt
 - B) Samaria
 Acts 8:14-17
 - C) Ends of the Earth
 Acts 19:1-7 (Ephesus)

- B. Experiential Confusion Based On an Unbiblical Gospel & False Assurances
 - "2nd Blessings" often 1st Conversions
 - "Rededications" often Real Conversion
 - "Varsity Christianity" = Real Christianity
 - "Second Encounters" = True Encounter

- C. Confusion Based On Failure to Distinguish HS Indwelling from HS Filling
 - Filling & Indwelling similar Analogies
 - When empowerment is experienced (filling) confused with "indwelling"
 - People say "I got the Spirit" when they actually were empowered for service

- D. Confusion Based On Failure to Distinguish HS Baptism from HS Filling
 - The Evidence of "Filling" equated with the Evidences of HS Baptism in Acts
 - Remember the Distinctions in HS action
 - Recognize God's purposeful separation of the timing HS actions in Acts
