A Word about “Genres”

- From the word “Gender” (male / female)
= Type or Category or Sort
- An Important Distinction (in HS texts)
 - 1) Narrative = Descriptive Texts
 - 2) Didactic = Instructive Texts

1. (Summary) “Baptism of HS” in Acts

E.g.: Conversion Texts

- **Narrative Text (Saul – Acts 9)**

- **Bright Light (v.3)**

- **Knocked Down (v.4)**

- **Audible Voice (vv. 4, 7)**

- **Stages Prescribed (v.6)**

- **Blinded (vv.8-9)**

- **Sight Restored & Sp. Indwelt (vv.17-18)**

E.g.: Conversion Tests

- Didactic Text (**Romans 10:9**)

“if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.”

1. (Summary) “Baptism of HS” in Acts

E.g.: Baptism of the Holy Spirit Texts

- Narrative Texts

- Acts 2 = Disciples

- Acts 8 = Samaritans

- Acts 10 = Italians

- Acts 19 = Ephesians

(These are “accepted” prior to HS manifestations)

1. (Summary) “Baptism of HS” in Acts

E.g.: Baptism of the Holy Spirit Texts

- Didactic Texts

Romans 6:3-4 Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life.

1. (Summary) “Baptism of HS” in Acts

E.g.: Baptism of the Holy Spirit Texts

- Didactic Texts

1 Corinthians 12:12–13 For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves or free—and all were made to drink of one Spirit.

Exodus 29:42-45 It shall be a regular burnt offering throughout your generations at the entrance of the tent of meeting before the LORD, where I will meet with you, to speak to you there. There I will meet with the people of Israel, and it shall be sanctified by my glory. I will consecrate the tent of meeting and the altar. Aaron also and his sons I will consecrate to serve me as priests. I will dwell among the people of Israel and will be their God.

So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone, in whom the whole structure, being joined together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord. In him you also are being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit.
