Application Questions

These questions are provided for your further study and application of today's sermon. Thoughtfully writing out the answers to these questions will help to drive home the point of today's study. It is also helpful when you are able to discuss your answers with others.

- 1. Read **Luke 16:14-15**. While, of course, not all of what people value is an "abomination in the sight of God," many things are as the context highlights. What are some of the things that our present culture exalts and highly values which are an abomination to God, and that unfortunately become a temptation to many Christians?
- 2. Read **Psalm 50:17-21** and **Romans 2:4-5**. Note carefully what prompts the thought that God must be "like us" in Psalm 50:21. What does Romans 2 teach us about this?
- 3. Read **Jeremiah 5:30-31** and **6:13-19**. What does this teach us about people's preferences regarding preaching and teaching? How does "greed" (6:13) factor in to this problem?
- 4. Read **2 Timothy 4:1-5**. While you may not be a "career preacher" like Timothy, you do have a responsibility in the ministry of evangelism and discipleship. What aspects of this sobering commission apply to the way you go about that ministry?
- 5. Read **2 Timothy 2:15** and **3 John 4**. What motivations do we find in these texts for being faithful to the text in our evangelism and discipleship of others?
