- 1. Read **Matthew 9:35-38**. What are some things in the average Christian's life that keep him from having a greater concern for "the harvest" of people who need to become followers of Christ? What are some of the related specifics for which we should be praying in light of Christ's command in v.38?
- 2. Read **1 Corinthians 12:14-20**. Why is it difficult for many Christians to accept this important corrective? How would you counsel someone to help them see the importance of their role in the church?
- 3. Read **Romans 12:3-13**. What are the most convicting aspects of this text as you read through it? What steps can you take to address the areas of your life which are a part of that conviction?
- 4. Read **1 Corinthians 6:9-11**. What negative impact does it have on your service for Christ when you are preoccupied with guilt over your pre-Christian life? Why is being fixated on those years an insult to the work of Christ and the truth of v.11?
- 5. Read **Matthew 6:24** and **Luke 16:9**. How does the use of money described in Luke 16:9 safeguard us from the problem highlighted in Matthew 6:24?
