- 1. Read **2 Corinthians 5:17**. How do you distinguish total perfection from a radical redirection? When you read this classic text what are some of the transformative changes in your life that come to mind?
- 2. Read **Ezekiel 36:26-27** and **1 Peter 2:11**. Why is it important to understand the difference between the core desires of your "new heart" and the lingering "passions of the flesh"? What is the risk of thinking both come from the same source within you?
- 3. Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-2; Hebrews 3:6 and 3:14. How would you respond to someone who says that these "holding fast" passages prove that we "earn" our salvation?
- 4. Read **Hebrews 10:23-25**. From your experience, how can you attest to the ways fellow Christians help you "hold fast the confession of your hope without wavering" (v.23)?
- 5. Read **Matthew 26:33-35** and **John 21:18-22**. Though Jesus explained that Peter's devotion would be imperfect, why is his stated resolve (along with Christ's confirmation in John 21) that Peter would be devoted to Christ for the duration an important perspective for Peter's daily life?
