- 2. Read **Matthew 10:34-39**. Elsewhere the Bible establishes the important value of family relationships, but here Jesus makes clear that at times our submission to his Lordship will interfere and disrupt even the closest earthly relationships. What are some of the situations in which this unavoidable clash takes place?
- 3. Read **1 Corinthians 15:33**. Give an example or two of this simple principle at work in the lives of twenty-first century adults.
- 4. Read **Galatians 6:2**. What are some of the ways you can live out this verse more intentionally for those you know who "hear God's word and do it"?
- 5. Read **1 John 3:11-15**. What will you do this week to purposefully and thoughtfully demonstrate this fundamental Christian trait?
