- 4. Read **Psalm 56:1-4**. What is the connection between faith and fear?
- 5. Read **Romans 11:33-36**. After a lengthy discussion about the present reality of evil, Paul wraps up with this doxology. What is required to have such a positive, worshipful perspective after considering the inclusion of such terrible things in God's plan?
