


The WILL TO LIVE is a legal document that you can sign which:

- Is a legally binding pro-life alternative to the traditional Living Wills
- Names someone to make health care decisions for you (your "heath care agent") if you develop a condition that makes it impossible for you to speak for yourself (become "incompetent"), and



E. The Question of Exodus 20

- Murder (*ratscah*) = malice aforethought

And if he pushed him out of hatred or hurled something at him, lying in wait, so that he died, or in enmity struck him down with his hand, so that he died, then he who struck the blow shall be put to death. He is a murderer.



B. War as a “Last Resort”

Titus 1:7

For an overseer, as God's steward, must be above reproach. He must not be arrogant or quick-tempered or a drunkard or violent [not a striker / pugnacious] or greedy for gain,

Psalm 68:30

Rebuke the beasts that dwell among the reeds, the herd of bulls with the calves of the peoples. Trample underfoot those who *lust after tribute*; scatter the peoples who ***delight in war.***

Deuteronomy 20:10

When you draw near to a city to fight against it, offer terms of peace to it.

B. War as a “Last Resort”

Ezekiel 33:1

Say to them, As I live, declares the Lord GOD, I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked, but that the wicked turn from his way and live; turn back, turn back from your evil ways, for why will you die, O house of Israel?

Isaiah 1:18-19

C. Principles that Guide

1) *Jus ad Bellum* = Justified Causes

God has taken his place in the divine council; in the midst of the gods he holds judgment: “How long will you judge unjustly and show partiality to the wicked? Give justice to the weak and the fatherless; maintain the right of the afflicted and the destitute. Rescue the weak and the needy; deliver them from the hand of the wicked.”
