- 4. Read **Psalm 119:161-168**. How would you respond to someone who says you should focus less on the Bible and more on God? What do you think people mean by giving this kind of advice?
- 5. Read **2 Peter 1:19-21**. What will you do to personally engage with God's word this week? How can you improve the setting and focus of your mind during your study of God's word?
