- 4. Read **Deuteronomy 17:18-19** and **Isaiah 66:2**. Describe a proper fear of the Bible and why we should have it.
- 5. Read Psalm 25:14; 119:63; Malachi 3:16-18 and Acts 9:31. What will you do in response to this week's study to heighten an appropriate fear of God in yourself and those closest to you?
