



6. An Experience of Repentance A. It Is Essential



To which Abraham answers, "If they mingled wit "Do you th do not hear Moses and the Prophets, neither will they be convinced if someone should rise from the dead" (Lk.16:19suffered Jesus memorably impresses upon us in this story that the difference between heaven and hell, from the pages of both the Old and New Testaments, is one's response to the biblical call to "repent!" The message of the saving work of Christ came into sharp focus in the New Testament era, but the call to repentance in order to be "saved" is nothing new. If you go back through the Old Testament you will find an undeniable continuum as it relates to God's imperative call and the riches of his forgiveness. See this in Solomon's prayer, as he affirms the relationship between repentance ... if they turn their heart in the land to which they been carried captive, and repent and plead with and forgiveness.

8. A Sense of Forgiveness A. A Cleansed Conscience


