- 3. Read **2 Corinthians 11:13-15**. Why would life be so much easier if this insidious fact wasn't true, and what kind of precautions does this unfortunate situation necessitate for us as Christians?
- 4. Read **Galatians 6:10**. What specific good will you plan and purpose to do for these two categories of people this week?
- 5. Read **Titus 2:11-14**. What would you tell a Christian he might do to increase his passion and energy in order to spend more of his efforts doing good for others?
