- 2. Read **1 Corinthians 4:2**. In light of our study in Luke 16:10-12, how would you summarize what it means to be "faithful" as a steward of God's material resources?
- 3. Read **Matthew 6:31-34**. How could you live this year with a greater priority given to "the kingdom of God and his righteousness" than you did last year?
- 4. Read **Philippians 2:19-22**. Why is selfishness such an important concern that must be considered when thinking about our stewardship? What can you do to be more like Timothy this week?
- 5. Read **Hebrews 11:6** and **Matthew 6:19-21**. How would you respond to someone who tells you that it is sinful and selfish to take any interest in your eternal reward?
