





 - Ezra is the Author & Perhaps Compiler of Ez/Neh







- G. Tribes of Israel
 - Ten Tribes of North Falls to Assyria in 721
 - -- Conquered (not "Lost")
 - -- Some Intermarried with Foreigners
 - -- Some Relocate to South
 - > At Division (1 Kgs. 12)
 - > During Asa's Reforms (2 Chron. 15)
 - > At the Fall (2 Chron. 30 & 34)


- L. The Problem of Intermarrying



- Another Example of Career Advancement Colossians 3:22–24

Bondservants, obey in everything those who are your earthly masters, not by way of eye-service, as peoplepleasers, but with sincerity of heart, fearing the Lord. Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the inheritance as your reward.

G. Nehemiah's Prayer Life Nehemiah 2:4-5 Then the king said to me, "What are you requesting?" So I prayed to the God of heaven. And I said to the king, "If it pleases the king, and if your servant has found favor in your sight, that you send me to Judah, to the city of my fathers' outgraves, that I may rebuild it."

H. Opposition to the Project Nehemiah 4:1-3

Now when Sanballat heard that we were building the wall, he was angry and greatly enraged, and he jeered at the Jews. And he said in the presence of his brothers and of the army of Samaria, "What are these feeble Jews doing? Will they restore it for themselves?

H. Opposition to the Project Nehemiah 4:1–3

Will they sacrifice? Will they finish up in a day? Will they revive the stones out of the heaps of rubbish, and burned ones at that?" Tobiah the Ammonite was beside him, and he said, "Yes, what they are building—if a fox goes up on it he will break down their stone wall!"

And they all plotted together to come and fight against Jerusalem and to cause confusion in it. And we prayed to our God and set a guard as a protection against them day and night.

...you and the Jews intend to rebel; that is why you are building the wall. ... you wish to become their king. Then I sent to him, saying, "No such things as you say have been done, for you are inventing them out of your own mind." For they all wanted to Gufrighten us... But now, O God, strengthen my hands

I. God's Favor on the Project Nehemiah 6:15-16 So the wall was finished on the twenty-fifth day of the month Elul, in fifty-two days. And when all our enemies heard of it, all the nations around us were afraid and fell greatly in their own esteem, for they perceived that this work had been accomplished ou with the help of our God.

J. Revival Among the People Nehemiah 8:1–4

And all the people gathered as one man into the square before the Water Gate. And they told Ezra the scribe to bring the Book of the Law of Moses that the LORD had commanded Israel. So Ezra the priest brought the Law before the assembly, both men and women and all who could understand what they heard,

J. Revival Among the People Nehemiah 8:1–4

...And he read from it facing the square before the Water Gate from early morning until midday, in the presence of the men and the women and those who could understand. And the ears of all the people were attentive to the Book of the Law.

And Ezra the scribe stood on a wooden platform that they had made for the purpose. ...

They read from the book, from the Law of God, clearly, and they gave the sense, so that the people understood the reading.

 - -- Merchants Greedy for Gain on Sabbath




But I warned them... If you do so again, I will lay hands on you." From that time on they did not come on the Sabbath.
