- 4. Read **Psalm 37:5-11**. What are some of the heightened temptations we face the longer we are made to wait for the consummation of God's kingdom plans?
- 5. Read **Hebrews 10:23-25**. What added conviction do these familiar verses bring when they are read with a strong emphasis on our "faithful" God and the "promised" and scheduled second coming of Christ (i.e., "the Day")?
