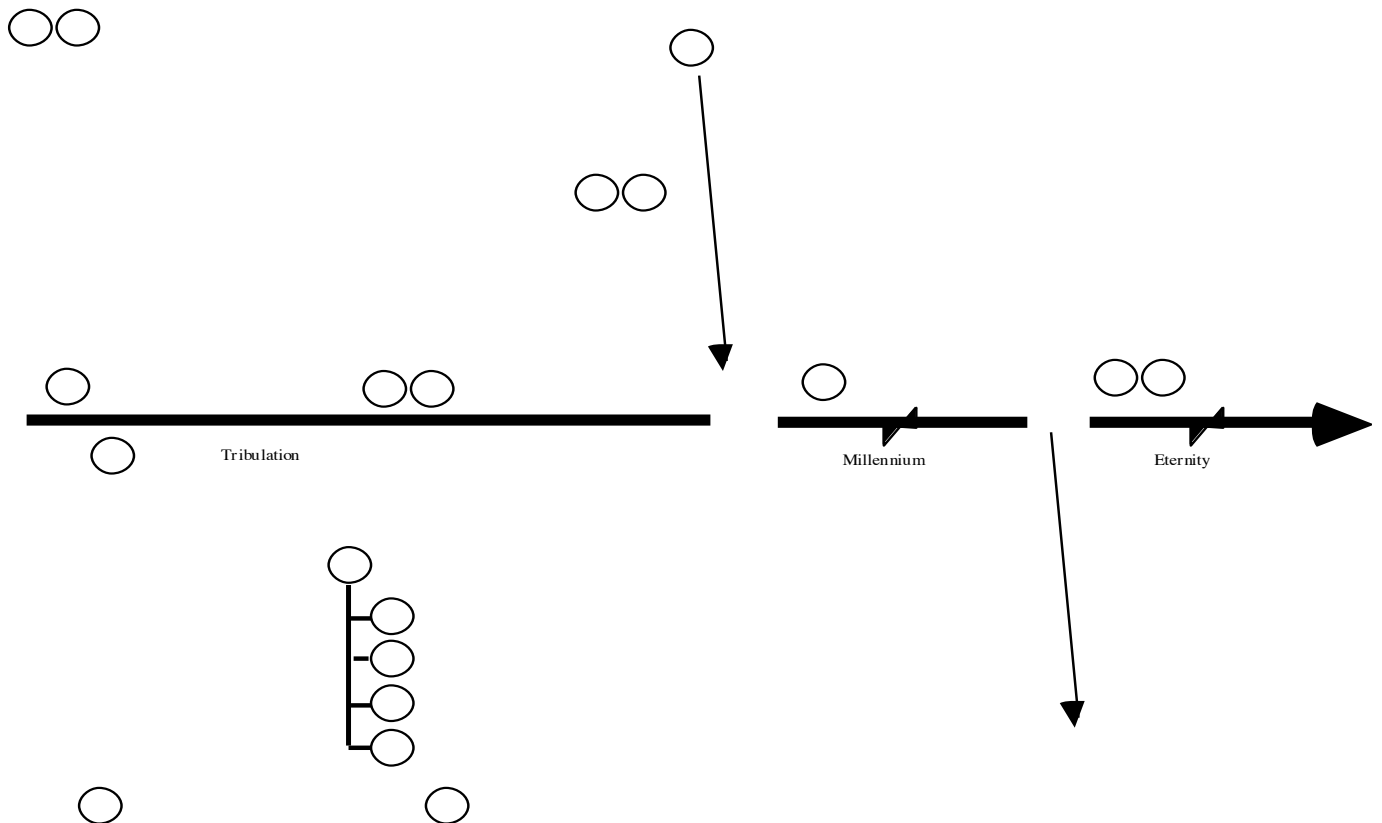

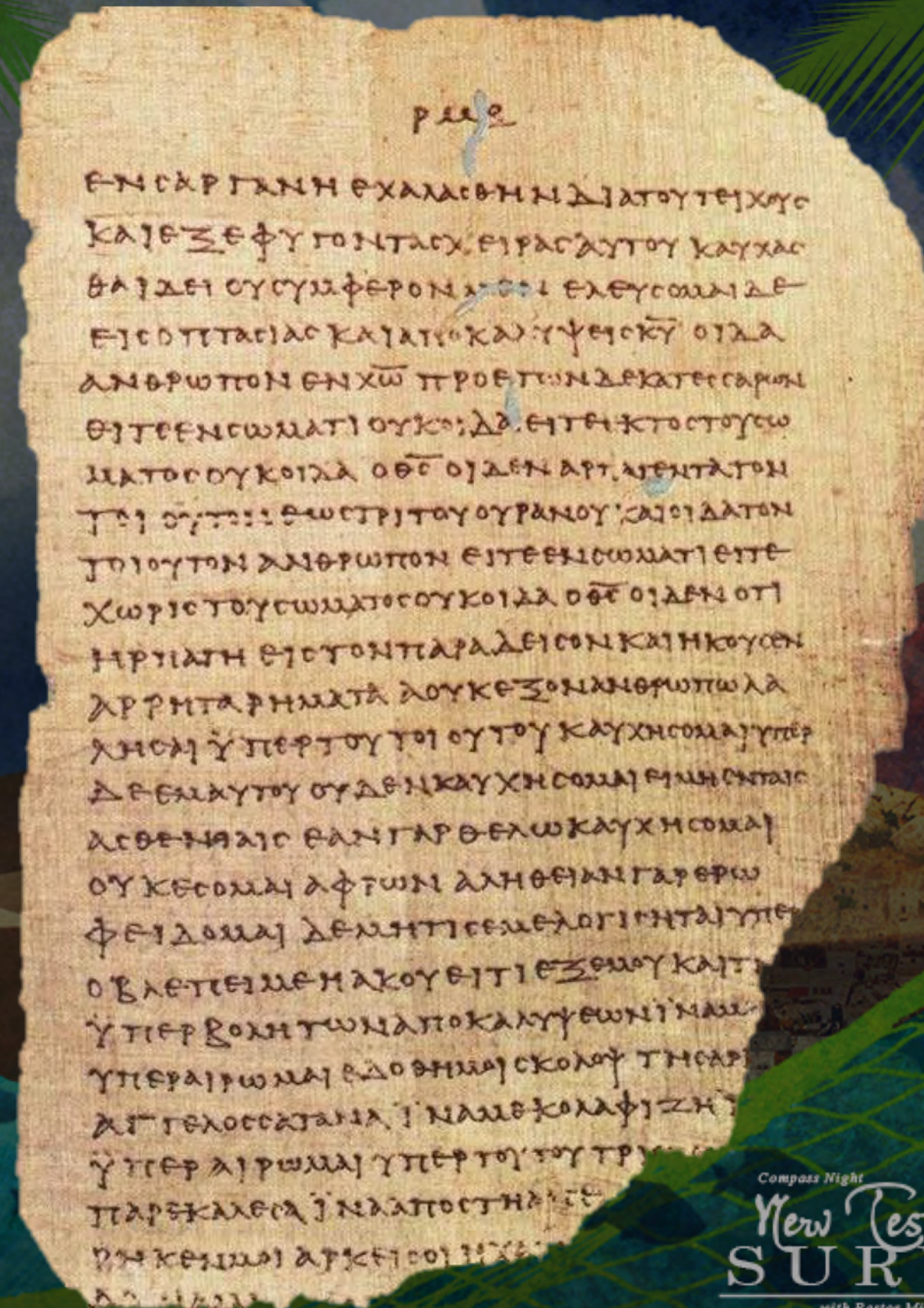

*2 John 1*

*The elder to the elect lady and her children...*

- John Didn't Generally Identify Himself Directly
- Early Church = “John, the Apostle”
- Style is Like John's Other Letters
- John, the Apostle, Son of Zebedee

- Likely from Ephesus
- $\approx$  AD 90

- Likely a Church, and it's Members

- This Metaphor continues in the Conclusion

*2 John 13*

*The children of your elect sister greet you.*

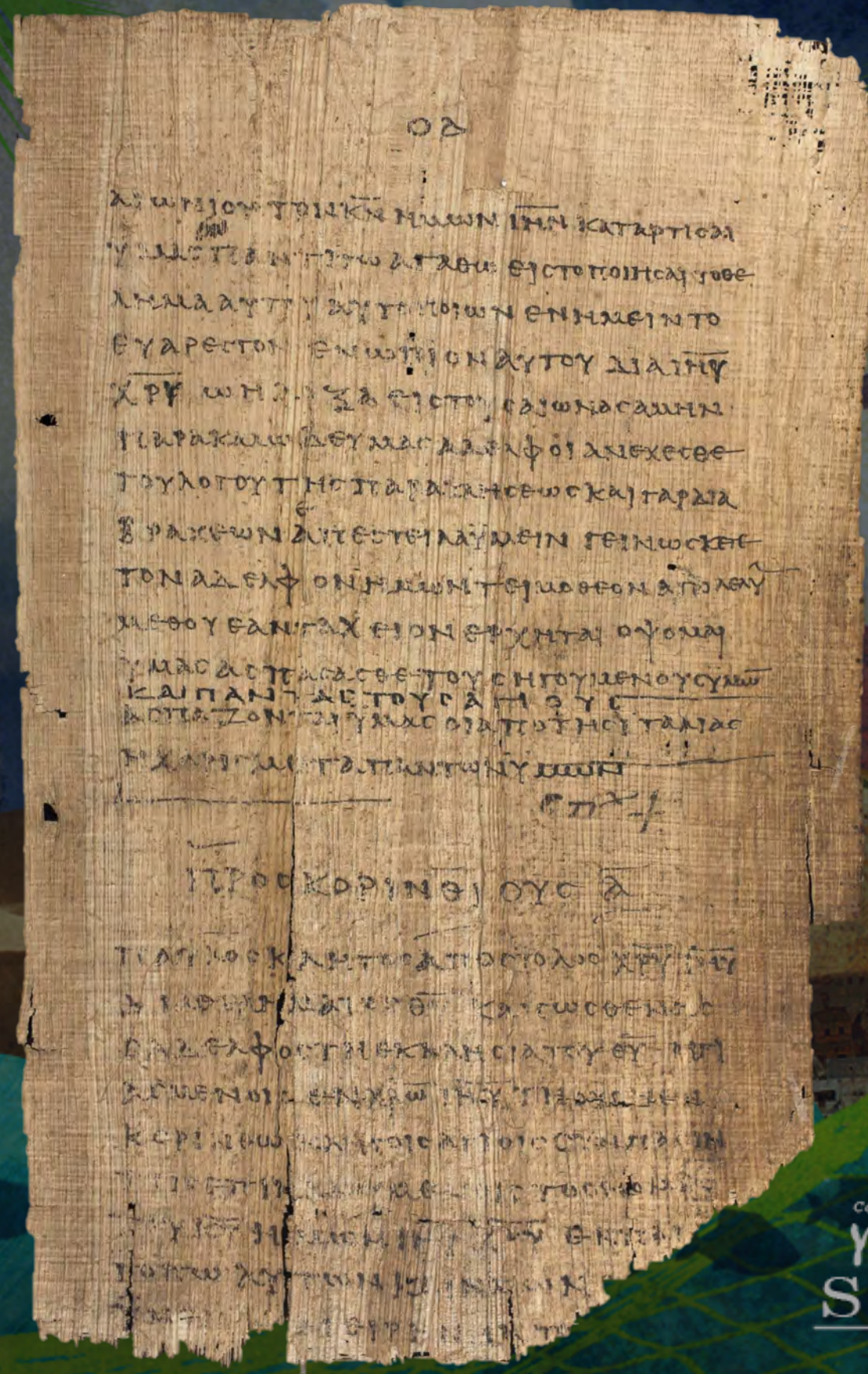

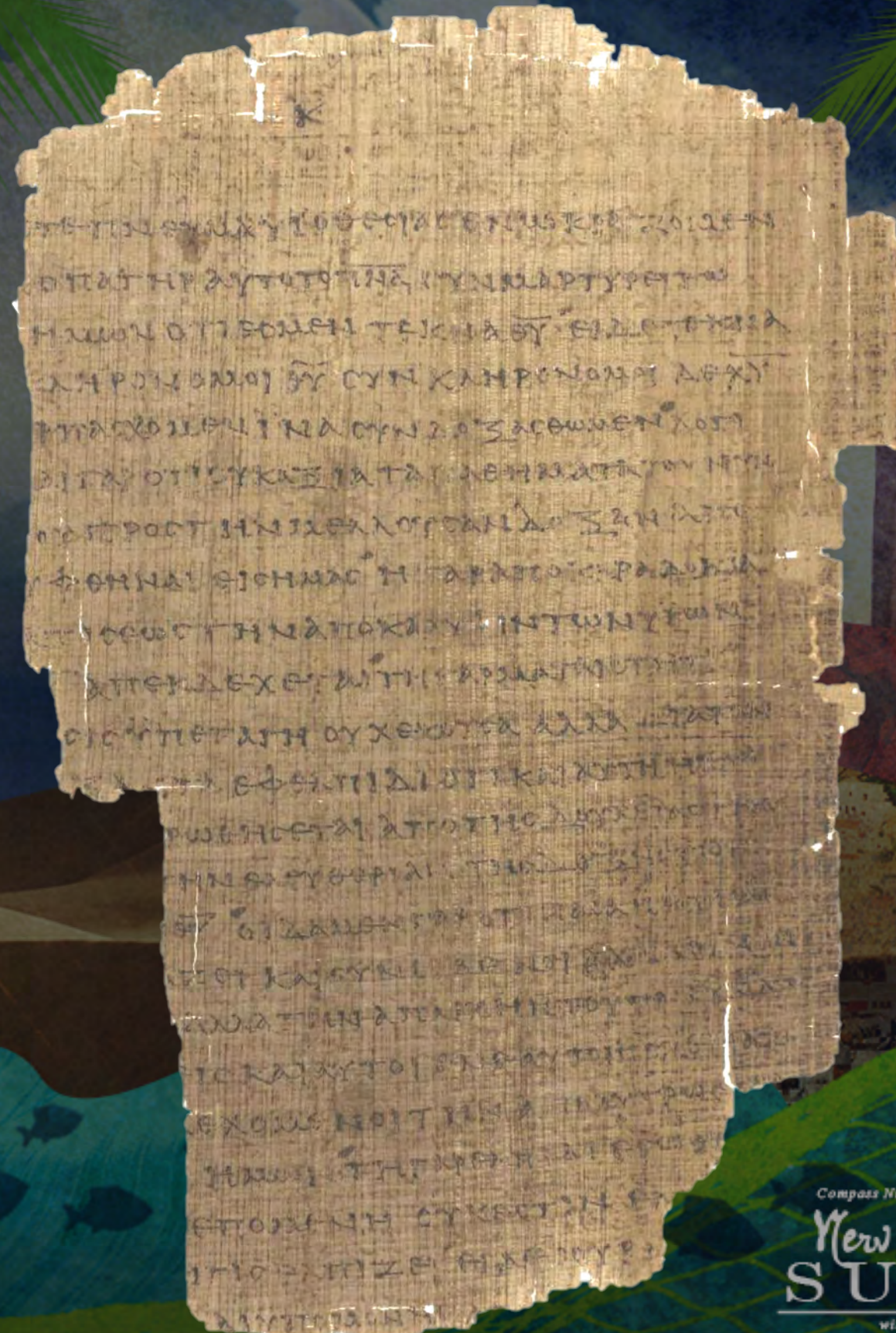

- AD 60 Earthquake in Laodicea – Long Reconstruction

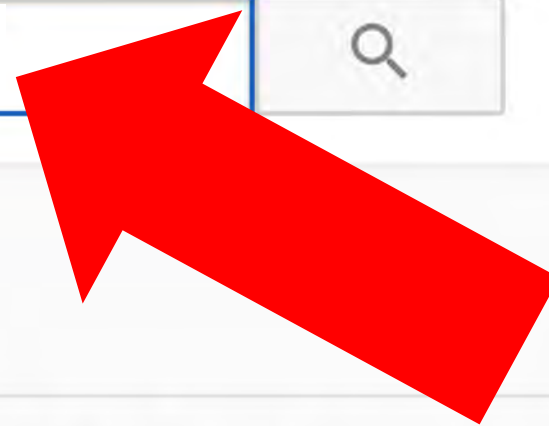

## E. Purpose

- To Describe the “Appearing of Christ”

### *Revelation 1:1–2*

*The revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave him to show to his servants the things that must soon take place. He made it known by sending his angel to his servant John, who bore witness to the word of God and to the testimony of Jesus Christ, even to all that he saw.*

- “Revelation” = Gk.: *Apokalupsis*  
-- “Disclose” / “Manifest” / “Unveil” / “Uncover”

Later the teacher explained to Steve what she had done. She explained how she took away the threat of a bad grade so that Robin could learn English literature. Robin ended up making straight A's on her own in that class.<sup>2</sup>

That's how God deals with us. Because of Christ's finished work, Christians already have an A. The threat of failure, judgment, and condemnation has been removed. We're in—forever! Nothing we do will make our grade better, and nothing we do will make our grade worse. In his life, by his death, and with his resurrection, Christ our substitute secured for us the everything, the A, that we come into this world longing for and yet are incapable of securing for ourselves. All the pardon, the approval, the purpose, the freedom, the rescue, the meaning, the righteousness, the cleansing, the significance, the worth, and the affection we crave and need are already ours in Christ. We don't need to add anything to it. The operative power that makes you a Christian is the same operative power that keeps you a Christian: the unconditional, unqualified, undeserved, unrestrained grace of God in the completed work of Christ.

As I said, the banner under which Christians live reads, "It is finished." So relax, and rejoice. Jesus plus nothing equals everything; everything minus Jesus equals nothing.

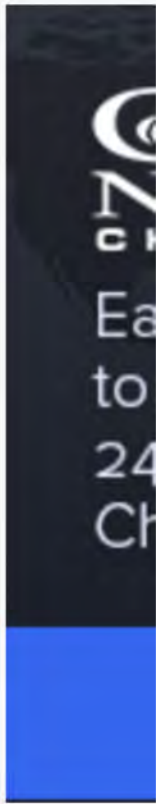
