- A. The Critics' Claims
 - "It has been translated thousands of times"
 - "It's message has evolved for generations"
 - "It has been corrupted through the centuries"
 - "It was constructed by politicians with agendas"
 - "Books were excluded to present a planned message"
 - "It was written centuries later based on oral tradition"
 - "It was shaped and edited by religious leaders"

The Bible's Claims 1) It is to be Taken as Factual & Historical ("true truth") 1 John 1:1-2 That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we looked upon and have touched with our hands, concerning the word of life the life was made manifest, and we have seen it, and testify to it and proclaim to you the eternal life, which was with the Father and was made manifest to us

2 Peter 1:16–18

For we did not follow cleverly devised myths when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but we were eyewitnesses of his majesty.  - A <u>Huge Number</u> of Old Copies
 - -- More than Any Other Ancient Book
 - -- Over 5,000 in Greek
 - -- Thousands in Other Languages
 - A Lot of Very Old Copies (Small Gap)
 - -- Closer to the Date of the Original than Any Other -- Fragments to Early 2nd & Possibly 1st Century

 - From Original Writings to Existing Copies
 - 2) DSS Confirmed Accuracy of Later Copies
 - Trusted Masoretic Texts Vindicated

B. Psalms

- There are more copies of Psalms than any other book by far.
- Of all the copies there are three extra Psalms found.
- The most famous and interesting is Psalm 151 because of its presence in the LXX.

Psalm 151 (LXX & DSS)

1) I was small among my brothers and youngest in my father's house: I tended my father's sheep. 2) My hands formed a musical instrument and my fingers tuned a psaltery. 3) And who shall tell my Lord? The Lord himself, he himself hear. 4) He sent forth his angel, and took me from my fathers' sheep, and he anointed me with the oil of his anointing. 5) My brothers were handsome and tall; but the Lord did not take pleasure in them. 6) I went forth to meet the Philistine; and he cursed me by his idols. 7) But I drew his own sword, and beheaded him, and removed reproach from the Children of Israel.
