4. Read **Philippians 3:12-16**. You are likely familiar with several of the things from his past that the Apostle Paul would not benefit from dwelling on (some are in the surrounding context of this text). What are some of yours?

5. Read 2 Timothy 4:14-18. In what specific ways can you identify with this text and what can you do to seek to maintain the kind of trust in the Lord exhibited in it?
