- 3. Read **John 12:43**. How can you avoid being trapped between these two loves? What are some ways to make sure you are decidedly focused on God's approval in your everyday life?
- 4. Read **Acts 8:36-38**. What would you say to a Christian who tells you he is too embarrassed to be water baptized? How would you counsel them through their apprehension?
- 5. Read **Acts 8:39-40**. How might a Christian maintain the joy and determination that motivated the ongoing work of the Ethiopian and Philip in these verses?
