- 2. Read 1 Peter 1:22 2:3. What have you found to be the experiential connection between a regular and receptive ingesting of God's word and your entanglement with envy? What can you do to strengthen your biblical appetite?
- 3. Read Psalm 73:1-14. In your own words, what are some of the things that Christians are sadly tempted to envy about non-Christians?
- 4. Read Colossians 3:1-10. How does a busy Christian practically do what vv.1-3 tells us, so that there will be an increasing defeat of what is listed in vv.5-9?
- 5. Read 1 Timothy 6:11-19. How do you envision a more victorious battle over the temptation of envy will make your present Christian life qualitatively better?
