- 1. Read **Romans 4:1-8** and **Colossians 1:12-14**. In what ways is this immediate and full change in status before God so different than many religious systems and even the way non-Christians are prone to think about salvation?
- 2. Read **Ezra 7:6, 10**. Some would quote these verses about one skilled in the Scripture, to support church leaders creating new doctrines and requiring Christians to follow practices not found in the Bible. Why is this an unwarranted conclusion?
- 3. Read **Ephesians 2:8-9** and **Romans 3:21-26**. What are some of the practical implications of affirming these truths about salvation when it comes to how we view ourselves, our forgiveness, and our Christian lives?
- 4. Read **Ephesians 2:10** and **James 2:14-19**. How is the role of good works often misunderstood? Why do you think people are prone to think that way? How would you biblically explain the role of good works and forgiveness?
- 5. Read **2** Corinthians 5:17 and Luke 6:43-45. What are some of the evidences of your salvation which bring you assurance that God has graciously made you a new person from the inside out?
