- 3. Read **1 Corinthians 1:10-12** and **Jude 3-4**. Why are churches that are splintered by personal or doctrinal rifts inherently weak? Where might the energy spent warring with one another be redirected if they were unified?
- 4. Read **Hebrews 5:11 6:1**. If everyone in your church took this passage to heart and diligently followed these instructions, how would it logically increase the strength and unity of the church?
- 5. Read **Romans 15:4-6** and **Philippians 2:1-2**. In your own words and based on the truths of these passages, how would you describe some of the benefits of your church being doctrinally and relationally on the same page?
