 Acts 17:10 The brothers immediately sent Paul and Silas away by night to Berea, and when they arrived they went into the Jewish synagogue. 11 Now these Jews were more noble than those in Thessalonica; they received the word with all eagerness, examining the Scriptures daily to see if these things were so. 12 Many of them therefore believed, with not a few Greek women of high standing as well as men. 13 But when the Jews from Thessalonica learned that the word of God was proclaimed by Paul at Berea also, they came there too, agitating and stirring up the crowds. 14 Then the brothers immediately sent Paul off on his way to the sea, but Silas and Timothy remained there. 15 Those who conducted Paul brought him as far as Athens, and after receiving a command for Silas and Timothy to come to him as soon as possible, they departed.

- 1. Read **2 Corinthians 4:1-6**. How does a consideration of these truths heighten your appreciation for the way you understood the gospel and how you continue to receive and grow through the preaching of God's word?
- 2. Read **Psalm 119:97-104** and **Psalm 19:10-11**. What experiences do you find increase your daily desire and attraction to learn and explore God's word?
- 3. Read **Jeremiah 23:28-32**. How would you describe the differences between the power of faithfully and accurately explained truths from God's written word, and the weakness of the twisted biblical concepts of false teachers?
- 4. Read **John 5:39**. Describe the kind of "religious life" that can miss the point of the gospel and God's word entirely and yet be busy reading it, studying it, and quoting it.
- 5. Read **Isaiah 55:8-11**. How does this text remind you of our absolute need for God's revealed and written truth, and how does it give you hope?
