## **Application Questions**

These questions are provided for your further study and application of today's sermon. Thoughtfully writing out the answers to these questions will help to drive home the point of today's study. It is also helpful when you are able to discuss your answers with others.

- 1. Read **James 4:13–15.** Since no one is promised tomorrow, how should that reality increase the urgency of your gospel conversations, and how can you do that while maintaining respect and gentleness toward those you speak with at the same time?
- 2. Read **John 9:4–5.** How does knowing that your own opportunity to share Christ could end at any moment increase your urgency in everyday encounters? What can you do to keep this in mind and adjust your priorities?
- 3. Read **Romans 10:13–15.** How does knowing that the gospel spreads both locally and globally through our church encourage you to serve faithfully here, and how does it inspire you to take a more active and thoughtful part in the life and service of our church?
- 4. Read **Hebrews 3:12–14**; **4:12**. In what practical ways do these verses motivate you to actively care for those in our church so that they stay anchored in Christ and responsive to God's Word?
- 5. Read **Acts 17:30–34.** Some mocked, some delayed, and some believed. How does Paul's willingness to proclaim the gospel with great urgency in spite of varied responses motivate you to keep speaking in a similar way this week?
