- 2. Read **1 Thessalonians 2:3-5.** What principle in this passage do you most need to guard in your own witness? How can you practically keep these truths in mind when you represent Christ in everyday conversations?
- 3. Read **Romans 1:16-17** and **Mark 8:38**. What has helped you the most in building courage to stand for Christ in your daily life? What practices or truths give you confidence when you're tempted to shrink back?
- 4. Read **Hebrews 12:2** and **2 Corinthians 6:9-10.** Give an example where you saw that the purpose of honoring Christ outweighed the difficulty or resistance you faced. What helped you stay focused on the bigger purpose?
- 5. Read **Revelation 1:7-8.** How does this prophetic glimpse of Christ's final triumph help you stay committed to your role as his ambassador today?
