- 1. Read **Ephesians 5:7-11.** Paul warns believers not to partner with darkness. As you think about your own life, what kinds of influences, people, or environments do you need to be more careful to avoid right now?
- Read Psalm 32:3-4 and Psalm 73:23-28. David's guilt led to misery, while Asaph's purity led to joy in God's
 presence. What lessons do you see in this contrast, and how does it challenge you to guard your walk with the
 Lord?
- 3. Read **1 John 1:6-10.** Since walking in the light involves continual confession and cleansing, how does this passage shape the way you deal with your own sin day by day?
- 4. Read **James 1:27.** How does actively pursuing holiness and good works serve as one of the best defenses against worldly influence? What new ways could you intentionally serve the Lord this week to help you stay unstained by the world?
- 5. Read **Hebrews 13:5-7.** When you live with a real sense that God is present and watching, how does that change the way you view money, possessions, and the kind of person you want to become?
